## Arkansaw

### Arkansaw Creek Park

## Stockholm

### Maiden Rock Bluff

North of Stockholm. State National Area open for trail hiking, wildlife viewing especially eagles, hunting, and challenging cross country skiing. Overlooks Mississippi River and Lake Pepin



### Stockholm Village Park & Campground



Follow Spring Street over the railroad tracks. Playground, short nature trail, beach (no lifeguard on duty), campsites (fees apply), picnic tables, public boat launch, & 750 foot pier. Closes 11 PM daily.

### Stockholm Institute or Stockholm Museum

Spring St. Swedish History  
12-5pm on weekends (April through the first weekend in December).

### Little House Wayside Cabin

N3238 County Road CC, Stockholm. Replica of Laura's birthplace, water pump, and picnic shelter.
